DIRECTOR'S BRIEF COMMENT ON THE FILM

"MY INTENTION WAS TO CREATE AN UNREALISTIC MOVIE. A COMIC-BOOK STYLE FILM ABOUT PHYSICAL ADOLESCENCE - ABOUT THE **BODY THAT CHANGES, GROWS** AND TURNS INTO A MONSTER"

The story is focused on the corporeality of an 11-year-old boy and the frustration it causes - the kid doesn't want to be noticed and belittled. He doesn't know what is happening with him. He rejects the fact that his transformation has begun. He escapes into his fantasy world - a cruel fairy tale where his contacts with his community and his mother - unable to accept that her son changes - seem ultimate and final. Baby Bump is a portrait of a child trapped in adolescence few say it out loud, but growing up really isn't for kids.
